


CCEJ's 2019-2020 Training Calendar

Trauma Sensitivity & Restorative Dialogue

This full-day training combines two core modalities of Restorative Justice through content presentation, experiential learning, role plays and self-reflective work to empower us to respond to challenges with others through a relationship-centered lens. In this training, you will hear about basic trauma theory, experience the impact of trauma on the body, and explore Restorative Practices as a trauma sensitive modality. Using this trauma-informed lens, we will then explore dialogue skills that affirm positive relationships and provide interventions to shift relationships towards accountability and self-directed actions.

Harm & Conflict Advanced Circlekeeper Training

Our 3-day Harm & Conflict Advanced Circlekeeper Training will take your Restorative Practices to the next level in situations where harm has occurred. Participants will learn specific strategies to address harm and conflict in restorative ways that center relationships and minimize exclusion. Building on our 2-day Community Building Training, this advanced skill-building session will help you unpack conditioned conflict responses, roleplay specific harm scenarios, and lead re-entry circles to give you firsthand practice with restorative responses. This training is recommended for all school personnel, especially those involved in any aspect of creating policies around or implementing student disciplinary practices.
